## **CALL FOR PAPERS**

### **INTERNATIONAL SCIENTIFIC CONFERENCE**

*Dear Esteemed Scholars, Researchers, Lecturers, Doctoral Candidates, Students, Administrators, and Those Interested in the Fields of Culture and Education,*

In the context of globalization, digital transformation, and the increasing expansion of intercultural dialogue, the identification, preservation, innovation, and dissemination of Vietnamese civilizational values have become increasingly urgent and significant, both academically and practically.

Van Hien University is organizing the International Scientific Conference entitled: **“Vietnamese Civilization from the Indigenous to the Global – Preserving, Innovating, and Disseminating Humanistic Values”**, with the aim of reaffirming the value of Vietnamese civilization throughout history, in contemporary life, and within regional and global interactions. At the same time, the conference seeks to expand new approaches to language, literature, culture, heritage, memory, education, media, and the digital humanities.

Conference Theme: **Vietnamese Civilization from the Indigenous to the Global: Preserving, Innovating, and Disseminating Humanistic Values**

#### **I. Conference Topics:**

The main topics of the conference include:

- ***Vietnamese Civilization: Identity and Indigenous Foundations in Historical Development***
- ***Language, Literature, and Cultural Discourse in the Construction of Vietnamese Identity***
- ***Cultural Exchange, Adaptation, and Dialogue: Vietnam in Regional and Global Interactions***

The Organizing Committee also welcomes other submissions that are relevant to the overall conference theme and aligned with the academic orientation of the program.



Authors of high-quality research papers will be invited to submit their manuscripts to regular issues of the *Asian Journal of Social Science* (Q2 Scopus/ESCI), the *Vietnam Social Sciences* (Vietnam Academy of Social Sciences), or the *Journal of Science – Van Hien University (JSVHU)* under a fast-track peer review process.

All papers accepted at ICSSH2026 will be published in the conference proceedings with an ISBN.

**Participants:** The Organizing Committee cordially invites submissions from:

- Scholars, researchers, lecturers, and experts from Vietnam and abroad;
- Doctoral candidates, graduate students, and students with relevant research;
- Administrators in the fields of culture, education, language, heritage, media, and the social sciences and humanities;
- Representatives of research institutes, universities, international organizations, cultural and educational institutions, and stakeholders interested in preserving and promoting Vietnamese civilizational values.

## II. Important Dates

The conference will be held on **July 18, 2026**. To facilitate the review process, proceedings editing, and organizational arrangements, the proposed timeline is as follows:

- *Full paper submission deadline: **June 10, 2026***
- *Notification of acceptance (after review/revision, if applicable): **July 5, 2026***
- *Deadline for confirmation of participation and submission of presentation slides: **July 15, 2026***
- *Conference date: **July 18, 2026***

## III. Submission Guidelines

**Language:** Submissions may be written in Vietnamese or English.

### Abstract Requirements

- Length: approximately 200–300 words;
- Clearly state: title, research objectives, methodology, data/scope, and main findings or arguments;
- Include 3–5 keywords;
- Provide full author information: full name, affiliation, email address, and phone number.



## Full Paper Requirements

- Papers must be original, unpublished, and not under consideration elsewhere;
- Length: approximately 4,000 - 7,000 words;
- Format: Times New Roman, font size 12, 1.5 line spacing, standard margins;
- Structure should include: title, abstract, keywords, main content, and references;
- Citations and references must follow APA 7th edition.

**Submission Method:** Authors should submit their full papers by completing the submission form via the conference link: <https://forms.gle/g9ZR94eDxiY2zuFh7> ; or by scanning the QR code
